Below is the Remote Learning plan for you child that mirrors the provision being delivered in school this week. Each week we will be setting a **Literacy**, **Phonics** and **Number** activity to complete, as well as the **Shape of the Week** and a **Song of the Week** to sing. All of these activities can be repeated in different contexts throughout the week to strengthen your child's understanding. These activities will sometimes be supported by other resources that will be available to view or download from the **Documents** tab on Tapestry and from the Thoresby Primary School website (<https://thoresbyprimaryschool.org.uk/learning/fs1/>). The level of support provided will be reduced now that we know nurseries are open to everyone again, but may prove useful for those children isolating due to a positive case in the family. We look forward to seeing the work you complete at home when you upload **Observations** on Tapestry and will endeavour to provide feedback for completed tasks.

Everyone at Thoresby appreciates what a strange and difficult time we are living in right now and the extra challenges that have been placed upon you for the education of your children. We also appreciate that the learning environment at home does not always allow for the same daily structure as classroom learning. Choose the best, most appropriate times throughout the day to learn with your child and remember that every little thing helps. 

FS1 Plan for w/c Monday 18th January

The focus of this week will be to learn how to **Keep Safe** and **Keep Clean**. The children will be exploring and identifying dangers in the classroom and playground and consider the best way to stay safe. We will be learning that 'We only get one body' and we need to know how to look after it.



Literacy

This week we are focusing our discussions on literacy on **Keeping Safe** and **Keeping Clean**

We will be looking at a story called *Look Out!* and identifying the dangers faced by the characters. You can do the same thing with different stories as well. The key words we will be using are **Safe**, **Danger** and **Hurt** and will discuss what to do if something is dangerous (e.g. who to ask for help).

Later in the week we will be thinking about how to keep the different parts of our body **Clean** and **Healthy**. As 'We only get one body', the children need to learn what to do every day to keep it safe and happy.



Phonics



This week in phonics we will be playing a game called **Zoe the Zookeeper**. You could use a photo or a toy from home to represent Zoe. At Zoe's zoo, the animals are grouped by the first sound in their name so a **s**nake, **s**loth and **s**nail would live together. Pick a sound (**sss**, **t**, **p**, **d** and **lll** are good examples) and think of a list of animals that share the same first sound.

After you have a list of animals, you can practice counting syllables in each animal's name.

Number

This week in number we are continuing to count groups of mixed objects. Arrange some things on a plate or a sheet of paper and ask the same questions as last week:

1. What type of things are in this group?
2. How many are there altogether?
3. How many of them are ?
4. How many of them are ?

Then exploring swapping the items out one-by-one while keeping the numbers the same.
