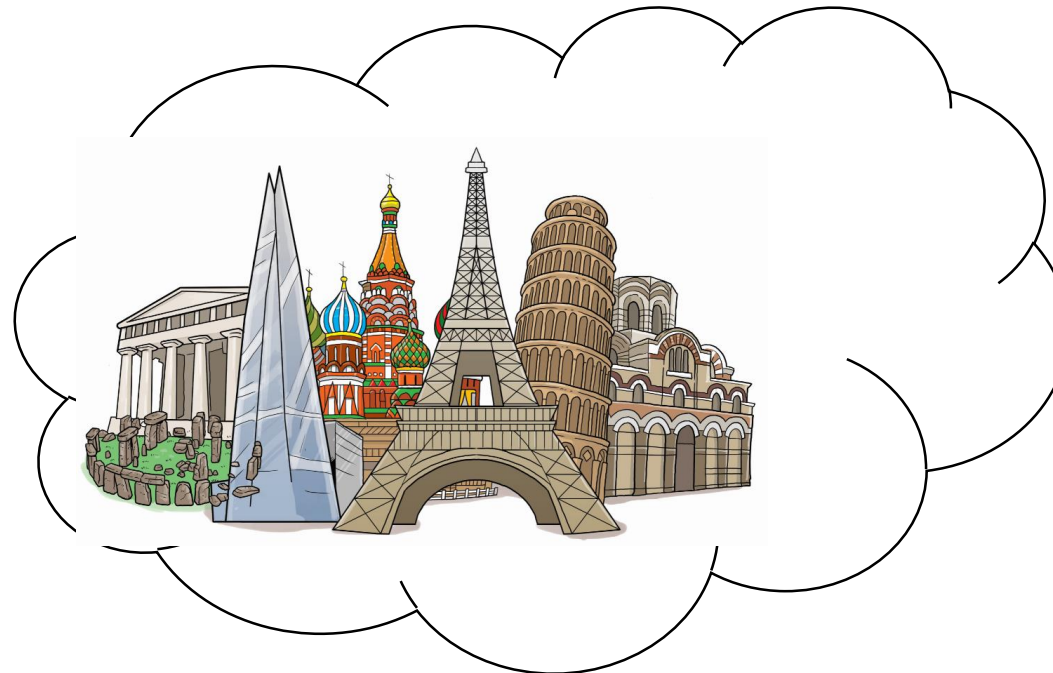
As people concerned with our environment we will:
