

Communication and Language

This term we will learn new vocabulary relating to different cultures and countries and use them when describing lives in different parts of the world.

Literacy

'Handa's Surprise' will support our topic learning about life in contrasting countries.

The text 'Oliver's Vegetables' supports our learning about healthy eating.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

By learning about different foods, we will develop an understanding of how to make healthy food choices.

We will also learn how to stay safe when accessing resources within our provision and when out and about on our way to and from school.

Expressive Arts and Design

Inspired by the beautiful illustrations in the texts which we will be focusing on, we will recreate paintings of people and animals using different media.

Physical Development

Our PE sessions will focus on balance and developing core strength to maintain a position. We will also learn how to transport equipment.

Maths

As mathematicians we will continue to build on our knowledge of 'one more than/one less than relationships between consecutive numbers. We will also learn to continue, copy and create repeating patterns. We will also compare length, weight and capacity.



Past and Present

As historians we will be exploring figures from the past. We learn about the lives of Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole.
