Curriculum Overview– Year 3/4 Spring 2022

English

As writers we will improve our grammar and sentence structure whilst learning about and writing non-chronological reports and stories.

In reading, our learning will be based on the text Iron Man by Ted Hughes.

Maths

As mathematicians we will continue to work on the four operations and study different methods.

Our learning will then move onto time. We will learn to tell the time and answer problems involving time.

Science

As scientists we will learn about electricity and sound. We will study the components of electrical circuits and think about how sound travels. During these lessons will work scientifically and carry out scientific experiments.

Geography

As geographers we will learn about different settlements. We will know that settlements across the world have similarities and differences and we will be able to name the key features of a village.

History

As historians we will learn about Britain's involvement in WW2 and the similarities and differences between life then and now.

Art

As artists we will study the work of David Hockney, who is considered one of the most influential British artists of the 20th century. We will be inspired by his work and create our own landscape pictures.

D&T

As design technologists we will evaluate existing products, design and make our own and begin to understand that products are not always used for their purpose.

Computing

As computer scientists we will delve into the world of coding. We will use, debug and create different programs.

RE

Our learning will be based around this question:

Music
