# Curriculum Overview– Year 3/4 Spring 2022

## English

As writers we will improve our grammar and sentence structure whilst learning about and writing persuasive texts and myths and legend stories.

In reading, our learning will be based on the text Iron Man by Ted Hughes.

## Maths

As mathematicians we will continue to work on the four operations and study different methods.

Our learning will then move onto money and decimals, linking this in with place value.

## Science

As scientists we will learn about rocks and living things and their habitats. We will study the different types of rock and think about their properties. Also, we will enjoy looking at animal habitats. During these lessons will work scientifically and carry out scientific experiments.

## Geography

As geographers we will learn about Greece. We will know where Greece is within the world and study its human and physical features. We will also study Athens as a city in depth.

## History

As historians we will learn about Ancient Greece. We will study key events on a timeline, look into the democracy and learn about the influences on the western world.

## Art

As artists we will study the work of Maggie Tookmanian, who is renowned for her attention to detail. We will learn how to use perspective and tone within our own work.

## D&T

As design technologists we will be looking at food and nutrition. We will study recipes and food preparation whilst diving into the world of traditional Greek food.

## Computing

As computer scientists we will delve into the world of information technology. We will enhance our typing and presentation skills.

## RE

Our learning will be based around this question:
