# Curriculum Overview– Year 6 Summer 2022

## English

As writers, we will improve our spelling, grammar and punctuation skills by writing narrative, explanation and persuasive texts.

In reading, our learning will be based on the text Floodland by Marcus Sedgwick.

## Maths

As mathematicians, we will continue to develop our problem solving and number skills in a range of different ways.

We will be looking at real-life maths problems and preparing the children for the Key Stage 3 curriculum.

## Science

As scientists, we will practise working scientifically by carrying out our own investigations and observations. Our science topics this term will be focused around 'Electricity' and 'Animals Including Humans'

## Geography

As geographers, we will learn about Mexico as part of our Kaleidoscope festival. We will explore how the Mayans farmed the land. Our residential will also provide us with the opportunity to do some geographical field-work in Yorkshire.

## History

As historians, we will be learning about the ancient Mayan civilisation. We will look closely at their cultures, traditions and artwork. We will be using different sources of evidence to support our historical opinions .

## Art

As artists, we will continue to study the work of Demi Lang, focussing on sketching skills. During Kaleidoscope we will also explore some of the colourful artwork, which is native to Mexico.

## D&T

As design technologists, we will be learning about food technology. We will be creating our own savoury recipes using chocolate.

## Computing

As computer scientists, we be focussing on staying safe online and exploring ways of presenting information using computers.

## RE
