Curriculum Overview – Year 2 Autumn 2023

Literacy

As writers, we will explore how to write interesting descriptions which will bring our writing alive in our focus genres this term. We will start off with setting descriptions', poetry based around Hull Fair and then narrative based on contemporary themes.

As readers, we will be enjoying some key texts together, 'The tear Thief' and 'Amazing Grace'.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will begin looking at place value and developing our fluency of key number facts. We will be regularly counting in multiples of 2, 5 and 10 and recalling our number bonds. This will then support us as we move onto addition, subtraction and later on in the term, division and multiplication.

Science

As scientists, we will explore 'Animals including humans'. We will investigate how animals and humans change and develop from babies' to adults; learn about what living things need to survive and how to keep ourselves healthy and clean.



Geography

As geographers, we will be locating our capital city of London and the English Channel. We will become confident with exploring maps of the UK and begin to

identify the key geographical features' of London. We will also use directional language to locate these features.

History

As historians, we will explore different sources of evidence to learn about significant events. We will begin to learn about the Moon landing and formulate historically valid questions. Later in the term, we will explore the Great fire of London; find out who Samuel Pepys was and how this ghastly event happened.

<u>Art</u>

As artists, we will explore abstract art and pieces created by Jackson Pollock. We will learn about primary and secondary colours, what it means when we refer to colours as 'hot and cold' and how we can express our mood using different brush strokes and techniques.

Spelling

We will begin the year by reviewing phase 5 phonic knowledge before moving onto the Little Wandle Spelling Scheme.

D&T

As designers, we will begin to look at different mechanisms. We will build and test a wheel mechanisms and use this to build a model of a ferris wheel.

Computing

In computing, we will learn about computing systems and networks. We will explore technology around us and identify how its use can improve our world and school.

RE

Lead us not into temptation—right or wrong?

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Music
