

Curriculum Overview— Year Autumn 2023

English

This term we will use this text to support our learning. We will develop our comprehension skills and write our own adventure story. Later in the term, we will write our own poems after studying a range of poets.



Maths

As mathematicians we will be focusing on place value up to hundreds. Also, we will develop our understanding of the 4 operations and solve problems related to these.

Science

As scientists we will learn about animals including humans. We will identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food. Also, we will identify that humans and some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

Geography

As geographers we will learn about the River Humber and why it is so significant to Hull. We will be able to identify and name a range of human and physical features of Hull.

History

As historians we will learn about Hull's fishing industry and the life and achievements of Lilian Bilocca.



Art

As artists we will look at how the artist
Paul Klee creates different moods with colour.



D&T

In design technology lessons, we will be focusing on cooking and nutrition. We will follow a simple recipe to make fish pie.

Computing

In computing we will understand computing systems and networks.
