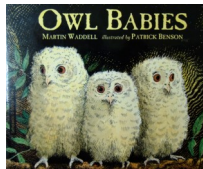

Curriculum Overview– Year 1 Autumn 2023

English

This term we will use these texts to support our learning. We will develop our comprehension skills and write using a range of genres.



Maths

As mathematicians we will be focusing on counting in different ways and place value. We will also be practising addition and subtraction.

Science

As scientists we will learn about different animals and begin to sort them based on their features. We will also be observing the weather changes throughout the season.

Geography

As geographers we will focus on the local areas and explore the Dukeries. Our farm trip will enable us to explore the geographical features of a farm.

History

As historians we will explore Thoresby Primary School and its significance in history.

Art

As artists we will take inspiration from Pablo Picasso and explore the mediums he used to create interesting pieces.

D&T
