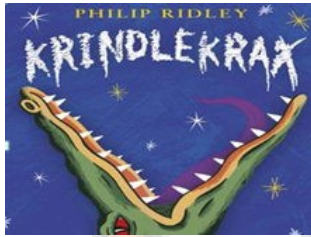

Curriculum Overview– Year 4 Autumn 2023

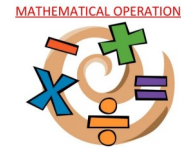
English

This term we will use this texts to support our learning. We will develop our comprehension skills and write our own dilemma story. Later in the term, we will write non-chronological reports.



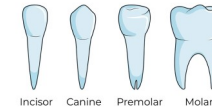
Maths

As mathematicians, we will be focusing on place value up to thousands. Also, we will develop our understanding of the 4 operations and solve problems related to these.



Science

As scientists, we will learn about animals including humans. We will identify the different types of teeth, study the digestive system and learn about food chains. Later in the term, we will look at different states of matter.



Geography

As a geographer we will learn about the city of York and why it is so significant to the Vikings. We will be able to identify and name a range of human and physical features of York.

History

As a historian we will learn about the power struggle between the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings.

Art

As artists we will look at how the artist David Hockney produced a variety of work using different mediums.

D&T

In design technology lessons, we will be focusing on mechanical systems, exploring parts that move and how they work.

Computing
