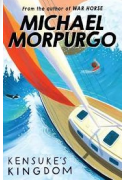

Curriculum Overview– Year 6 Autumn 2023

English



As writers, we will improve our spelling, grammar and punctuation skills by writing a narrative and a biography.

In reading, our learning will be based on the text, Kensuke's Kingdom. We will be using skills such as inference, prediction and retrieval to understand the text.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will consolidate and extend our place value knowledge. We will then move onto the four operations and these in a range of problem solving questions.

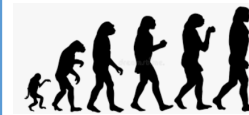

Science

As scientists we will study light. We will learn about the patterns in which light travels, as well as carrying out an investigation based



around shadows.



We will also be studying evolution and inheritance where we will investigate how animals can adapt to

History

As historians we will learn about the spread of the Roman Empire. We will study a range of primary and secondary sources as well as learning why the Romans eventually left Britain.



Computing

In computing we will be learning about search engines and different methods of online communication. We will also look at e-safety and how to keep ourselves safe.



Art

As artists we will explore mosaics, an art form brought to Britain by the Romans. We will investigate the work of artists, Dino Maccini and Julie Sperling and their mosaic techniques.



Geography

As geographers we will learn about the geography of the Roman Empire. Our learning will be based around Rome and it's human and physical features which allowed the Romans to gain power quickly.



We will use our locational knowledge to look at a range of maps to explore themes such as climate and population.

D&T

As designers we will be investigating how the Romans planned their towns and the buildings within them. We will be exploring how CAD can support designs.
