

Curriculum Overview— Year 3 Spring 2024

Literacy

This term we will be using 'The Firework Maker's Daughter' to support our learning. We will develop our comprehension skills and write our own adventure story. Later in the term, we will write our own explanation and instructional texts.



Maths

As mathematicians we will be exploring money and decimals. Also, we will develop our understanding of the 4 operations and solve problems related to these. We will deepen our place value knowledge.

Science

As scientists we will learn about rocks and soil. We will identify different types of rocks, learn how they are formed and look



at the fossilisation process. We will use our investigation skills to test the properties of different rocks and soils.

Geography

As a geographer we will learn about rivers and mountains. We will begin with exploring the water cycle and then move on to look at major rivers and mountains in the UK. We will study flooding and the impact this can have.

History
