# Curriculum Overview– Year 1 Spring 2024

## English

This term we will use these texts to support our learning. We will develop our comprehension skills and write using a range of genres.



## Maths

As mathematicians we will be focusing on different calculation methods. We will also be continuing to learn more about place value and moving on with our work on addition and subtraction.

## Science

As scientists we will learn about the uses and suitability of every day materials and how they are changed by bending, stretching, squashing and twisting.

## Geography

As a Geographer we will learn about our local area and compare that to the Isle of Coll in Scotland.

## History

As a Historian we will learn about inventions from the past. We will look closely at the design of the bicycle and the changes that have been made over time.

## Art

As artists we will be exploring different drawing techniques. We will be using techniques like sketching and shading.

## D&T

In D&T we will look at the design of the bicycle and specifically the use of axles.

## Computing

In computing we will use new found computing skills and knowledge to improve our coding skills.

## RE

The RE theme is friendship. We will be looking at the importance of friendship in different religions.
