English

This term we will use these texts to support our learning. We will develop our comprehension skills and write using a range of genres. We will compose our own fantasy stories, discussion texts, non-chronological reports and poems.

English

As mathematicians we will be working on money and decimals. We will then move onto place value extending our number knowledge up to 700,000. Later on in the term we will be focussing on fractions and percentages. We will study different methods and then use the most efficient ones when solving problems.

Maths

As scientists we will study forces, materials and learn all about animals including humans. We will learn about the properties of materials and how they interact with each other. Then we will learn about the patterns found in growth processes within different groups of species. We will work scientifically and carry out experiments while doing so.

Science

As a geographer we will learn about market towns. We will be developing our map skills and using these on our trip to Pocklington. We will be focussing primarily on our local area of East Yorkshire. We will be going on a trip to Pocklington (which is a market town) to complete map work.

Geography

As a historian we will learn about The Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. We will learn about this era and focus in on the inventions they developed. We will use sources of evidence and think about bias within these. We will be visiting Murlington park to learn about the Stone Age.

History

As artists we will explore key techniques of metal and iron work. We will be producing our own jewellery, using symmetry and patterns.

As designers we will be studying healthy food choices and how to cook bolognese. Then we will be learning all about structures.



In computing we will learn all about creating media. We will be recording and editing videos, taking into consideration different filming techniques. The videos will be in the style of a YouTube reviewer. We will also be looking at databases.
