Curriculum Overview— Year 4 Summer 2024

English

This term we will use this texts to support our learning. We will develop our comprehension skills and write our own myths and legends story.

Later in the term, we will learn how to write persuasively.



Maths

As mathematicians, we will be focusing on place value up to seven thousand and Roman Numerals up to 100. Also, we will develop our understanding of the 4 operations and solve problems related to these.

Science

As scientists, we will learn about how sounds are made, how they travel and how different pitches are produced. Later in the term, we will learn about animals and their habitats.



Geography

As a geographer, we will learn about Athens as the capital city of Greece. We will explore its human and physical features and how Athens compares to London.

History

As a historian we will learn how the life and achievements of ancient Greek life has influenced the western world and left a cultural legacy

<u>Art</u>

As artists we will look at Ancient Greek pottery and make our own replicas.

In design technology lessons, we will look at different types of fastenings to attach materials together. Later in the term, we will be looking at different types of structures.
