Communication and Language

This term we will identify new vocabulary in the stories we read by our key authors: Nick Sharratt and Giles Andreae. We will learn how some words have more than one meaning.

Literacy

'Supertato' will help to develop our understanding of the structure of stories. We will also use adjectives to describe characters and the things they do.
