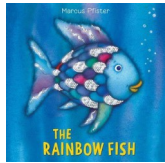

Curriculum Overview– Year 1 Summer 2024

English

This term we will use these texts to support our learning. We will develop our comprehension skills and our fluency skills such as handwriting, punctuation use and spelling.



Maths

As mathematicians we will be focusing on different calculation methods. We will also be continuing to learn more about place value and moving to look at multiplication in the form of repeated addition and division.

Science

As scientists we will learn about the different type of plants and their uses. We will learn about what plants need and grow our own plants, recording their growth.

Geography

As geographers we will learn about the local coast line and its features.

Practical learning for geography will take place during our school trip to Bridlington.

History

As historians we will learn about seaside holidays and how they have changed over time.
