Curriculum Overview– Year 3 Summer 2024

English

This term we will be using the book Charlotte's Web to support our learning. We will develop our comprehension skills and write our own adventure story endings. Later in the term, we will be writing discussion and narrative texts.



Geography

As a geographer we will learn about

biomes and climate zones. We will begin

with exploring arid climate zones and

then move on to look at tropical and po-

lar regions. We will study the impact this

has on a country.

Maths

As mathematicians we will be exploring the methods we have learnt in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Later in the term we will move onto

solving problems involving money and then working with different units of measure.



History
